Solution

Gallagher's Locker Management Solution ensures the best utilization of a site's locker resource natively from within Command Centre. Unlike key lockers, dynamic lockers become available as soon as the previous user leaves. This means you no longer require a separate locker for each person, saving you time and money.

Applications

- · Modern workplace environments, activity-based work environments, hot-desking, or co-working spaces.
- Tertiary institutions (students charging laptops/storing belongings).
- Military or police (securing weapons and other equipment).
- Visitors to work, gymnasiums, or swimming pools.
- Hotel or factory staff storage.
- Courier drop-off or pick-up storage.

Business value

- Attract and retain talented staff by providing a modern workplace environment. Lockers are a significant component of collaborative work environments.
- Impress stakeholders by providing a modern workplace environment. Modern workplaces support flexible work hours
 and temporary staff. Lockers enable staff to securely store their property as they come and go from site, or move
 around site (between floors). Temporary staff can securely store their belongings for the duration of their stay.
- Promote staff collaboration and interaction in the workplace. Lockers enable staff to securely store their belongings near their chosen desk.
- Minimize complexity by having one system for locker and building access; one audit trail; one notification system.
 A user can be notified of locker expiry.

Compelling event

- A company is building a modern office environment.
- A company wants to install locker hardware overseas, however the hardware is non-compliant for the country.
- The wrong user has been notified of locker expiry, due to using disparate systems.
- Locker break-ins have occurred; the company wants a more secure locker solution. Our solution supports locker forced
 alarms that can be sent via email and SMS. Locker occupancy is hidden from view, (i.e. no locker LED to show which
 lockers are in use).



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Use cases

- A locker is permanently allocated to a student. The locker can be allocated during the enrolment process.
- A visitor can self-allocate a locker by presenting their mobile phone at a T20 Terminal. Locker number (including date and time of expiry) is displayed on the T20 Terminal.
- A user requires access to a shared resource for a specified (purchased) period of time, (e.g. charging a laptop).
- A courier driver is allocated a locker for secure drop-off or pick-up of parcels. A notification can be sent to the locker owner when the locker is accessed.
- Temporary allocation. If the user's locker has expired, the user will need to visit the facilities manager to release the locker. The facilities manager can override the locker remotely and charge for the locker being released.
- There is a requirement for a user to be allocated a personal locker and access to a shared locker.

- Controller 6000, T20 Terminal, and HBUS I/O Board.
- Physical locker lock. Open sensor (for alarms) is optional.

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
